**Play these seven trumps**

As South would again respond with a conventional Lebensohl two no trump on any weak hand, the actual three-heart response suggests a hand in the 8-11 point range. With 18 high card points, North asks for a spade stopper by bidding three spades. As South has no spade stopper and no second suit to bid, the only option left is to bid four hearts.

Most declarers tend to panic when they are forced to play in a 4-3 fit. However, there are two simple rules for tackling them:

**Rule 1:** *If you have lots of winners, look for a plan that maintains control of trumps.*

**Rule 2:** *If you seem to have lots of losers, look for a plan that makes as many trumps as possible from ruffs in both hands!*

Which of these rules applies? Fairly clearly it is the first, for you have eleven potential winners.

So, how would you play four hearts when the defenders play three rounds of spades? You ruff the third spade in the dummy and see that your sole problem is to avoid two trump losers. If trumps break 4-2, you can simply play three rounds from the top, turning then to the minor suits. What can you do to guard against one defender (presumably West) holding five trumps? You should cross to your hand in one of the minors and play a low trump to dummy's ten. Even if this loses to the jack with East, you are still likely to make the contract when trumps are 4-2. If East returns a fourth round of spades, you can ruff with the bare king in dummy. You can then cross to the South hand and hope to draw trumps with the ace, queen and nine.

As the cards lie, the finesse of the ten pays off as West began with jack to five in the trump suit. After the ten of trumps holds, you cash the king of trumps and come back to hand in the other minor. After drawing two more rounds of trumps, throwing a diamond from dummy, you run the clubs. West makes just one trump trick to go with the two earlier spade tricks.

The recommended line loses when East holds a singleton jack of trumps but it is five times more likely that he holds a low singleton.

Tim više jer svi znaju kakva sam trtarošica kad su «visoki» kontrakti u pitanju te da ih izbjegavam k'o kugu zaobilazeći ih u širokom luku. No, ovaj put nisam imala kud kamo. Igramo protiv najdražih nam neprijatelja Splita 2 – Sloba i Edija. Budući je riječ o zadnjem kolu u kojem se odlučuje hoćemo li izboriti polufinale ili ostati doma plačući, ruke mi se tresu same od sebe i prije nego su karte podijeljene.

Beroš kao East otvori 3♣, pass, pass do mene, a u mene cijelo bogatstvo. Pravi El Dorado! ♠AKJ54 ♥KQ ♦AQ7 ♣A42 i jedino logično što mi se nameće jest kontra. Pass do Frana i 4♣. Oba majora pa ti, draga moja, biraj. Što ću sad? Što god da licitiram bit će mizerno i bojim se da ne ostanemo samo na pišljivoj manši, a imamo slem. A opet... kopka me što ako Frano nema ništa pts, nego su svi preostali u Edija. Ma! Idemo probati. Izvadim 4NT, partner mi pokaže 1 asa. Ujedno olakšanje, ali i novo razmišljanje. Ići na 7 ili ne. Ako morski vuk nema niti jedan ♣, na\*\*\*\*\* smo k'o žuti. Stavim 6♠ i napravim +1. Trefovi su bili 1:1.

I da dodam ovo. Još uvijek nisam otkrila je li moja licitacija bila ispravna i ako nije, kako bi glasila ona prava. Pametne glave, javite se!

Najčešći rezultat bio je 4 herc! Čak tri stola igrala su manšu u hercu, dva puta bilo je 6 pik, jednom 6 herc I jednom 3NT.
